### HC-L1-05 Keeping the Stable and Yard Safe and Organised

#### Scenario

You are working as a Stable Hand in a busy livery yard.

The yard manager wants you to create a Stable and Yard Safety Guide for new staff.

It should explain how to keep the stable environment safe, clean, and well-organised to protect both horses and people.

#### Tasks

##### Task 1 – Preventing Contamination (101 1.4)

Describe methods of minimising contamination of edible materials when moving them around the work area (e.g. hay, feed).

##### Task 2 – Safe Stacking (101 1.5)

Describe methods of stacking materials safely in the stable and feed room.

##### Task 3 – Welfare Requirements (109 1.1)

State the horses' basic welfare requirements and how to maintain their health and well-being in the stable.

##### Task 4 – Bedding (109 1.2)

List the types of bedding used in stabling and explain how they help maintain horses' health and well-being.

##### Task 5 – Cleaning Equipment (109 1.4)

List the types of equipment used when cleaning stables and describe:

- How to use them safely
- How to store them correctly

##### Task 7 – Yard Hygiene (109 1.5)

Give reasons for maintaining personal hygiene while working on the yard.

##### Task 8 – Reporting Procedures (109 1.6)

State the reporting procedures for faults and defects, and who they should be reported to.
