



## Assignment Brief

### HC-L1-A09 Safe Identification, Moving and Settling Horses

#### Scenario

You are working as a Stable Assistant at a riding school.

Part of your role involves catching and moving horses safely, identifying them correctly, and ensuring they settle into their new environment without stress.

The yard manager has asked you to create a Safe Identification and Horse Moving Guide for new staff and volunteers.

#### Tasks

##### **Task 1 – Identifying Horses (111 1.4, 119 1.2)**
